Student Services Committee June 12, 2018

Administration Center

Mrs. Gracias called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM. Committee members in attendance included: Melissa Gracias, Denis Ryan, Dr. James Gay, Dr. Kim Dryier, Lisa Shulman, Edgar Palacios, Robert Nolting, Sheli Thoss, Donald Vacha, Megan Krueger, Kevin Purcell, and Nadine Scordo. Also present were AAS Associate Principal Jennifer Tyrrell, and Board members Tony Serratore and Sue Dalton.

Review of committee meeting minutes - No comments or corrections were offered.

SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT

End of Year S4 Data - Dr. Dryier shared an S4 end of year update. She stated that the Student Services Committee focuses on the social and emotional portion of the S4 plan. Goals specific to student services were reviewed.

- D230 will guarantee a viable social and emotional curriculum and sound instructional supports that ensure college and career readiness for all students
- D230 will ensure all students master the viable curriculum and college and career readiness skills

Dr. Dryier explained that the social and emotional curriculum is delivered to D230 students through the Advisory program focusing on safety, relationships and interventions. She stated that the program is fluid and changes based on need. Dr. Dryier highlighted professional development opportunities for staff with the key focus on growth mindset, equity, and culture. Also highlighted were increases in co-curricular participation, increased enrollment in AP courses, decreases in Ds and Fs and Developmental Profile Assessment (*DAP*) results were shared.

2019- Title I Plan - Mr. Palacios, Special Program Coordinator, shared a presentation regarding the Title I Improvement Plan and the recent request from the district to move from targeted to school-wide within the Title I grant. He stated that the focus of the plan is parent/community involvement, consultation with stakeholders, identification of 'at risk' students, and accountability for aligning resources with goals.

STUDENT SERVICES

End of year discipline data / School Safety Reviews - Mr. Palacios shared a presentation regarding the end of the year discipline data and six year trends in the major infractions were presented to the committee. The presentation also included a presentation of the End-of-Year Safety reviews for the three schools. This presentation was part of the collaborative effort between the schools and their local fire and police departments. The last component of the presentation offered data regarding D230 Alternative School program.

Considerable discussion followed regarding maintaining safety readiness, collaboration with first responders, fire and safety critical thinking and response skills, improved fire drill protocols, and improved emergency notification.
