Summer School Programs – Not For Credit

The non-credit courses are designed to enhance skills needed for courses students intend to take during the coming school year. Preparation courses are held at each of the three campus locations as indicated within the description. Students from any campus may attend courses offered at another D230 campus. The cost for these classes varies in relation to specific timeframes. Families will be contacted if courses do not meet minimum enrollment criteria and need to be cancelled.

P2005 Prepare for Freshman Honors English

This course is designed for incoming 9th grade students who are recommended for Honors English but scored below the honors level. The course will provide an opportunity for students to experience the pace, and some of the skills and content of Freshman Honors English. This course is also an opportunity for all incoming Honors English students to preview some of the reading, writing and speaking skills that will be taught during the school year.

P2207 Prepare for AP Junior English

This course is designed to prepare all incoming junior students for a rigorous college level Advanced Placement English course. The course will focus on close readings of texts, specifically the summer reading selection, current event essays, editorials, and periodicals. Students will explore strategies for facilitating the adjustment from honors to the AP level. Students will also begin to define and apply rhetorical terminology to various texts in order to explicate and analyze authors' arguments. Additionally, students will have an opportunity to discuss the summer reading assignment.

P4040 Prepare for Honors Algebra

This course is designed for the incoming 9th grade student who was not recommended for Honors Algebra. The course will provide an opportunity for the student to acquire the skills to be successful in an honors algebra course. At the end of the class a proficiency exam will be administered. The results on this exam will determine the students' readiness for Honors Algebra. This course is also an opportunity for students who are recommended for honors algebra to review prerequisite concepts and skills.

E4040 Honors Algebra Enrichment

This course is not designed for students who were in Pre-Algebra during 8th grade.

P4085 Prepare for Honors Geometry

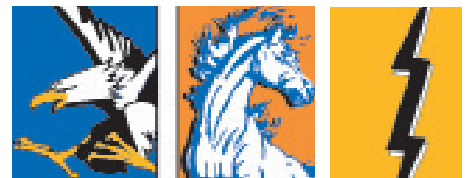
P8000 Prepare for the College Search
